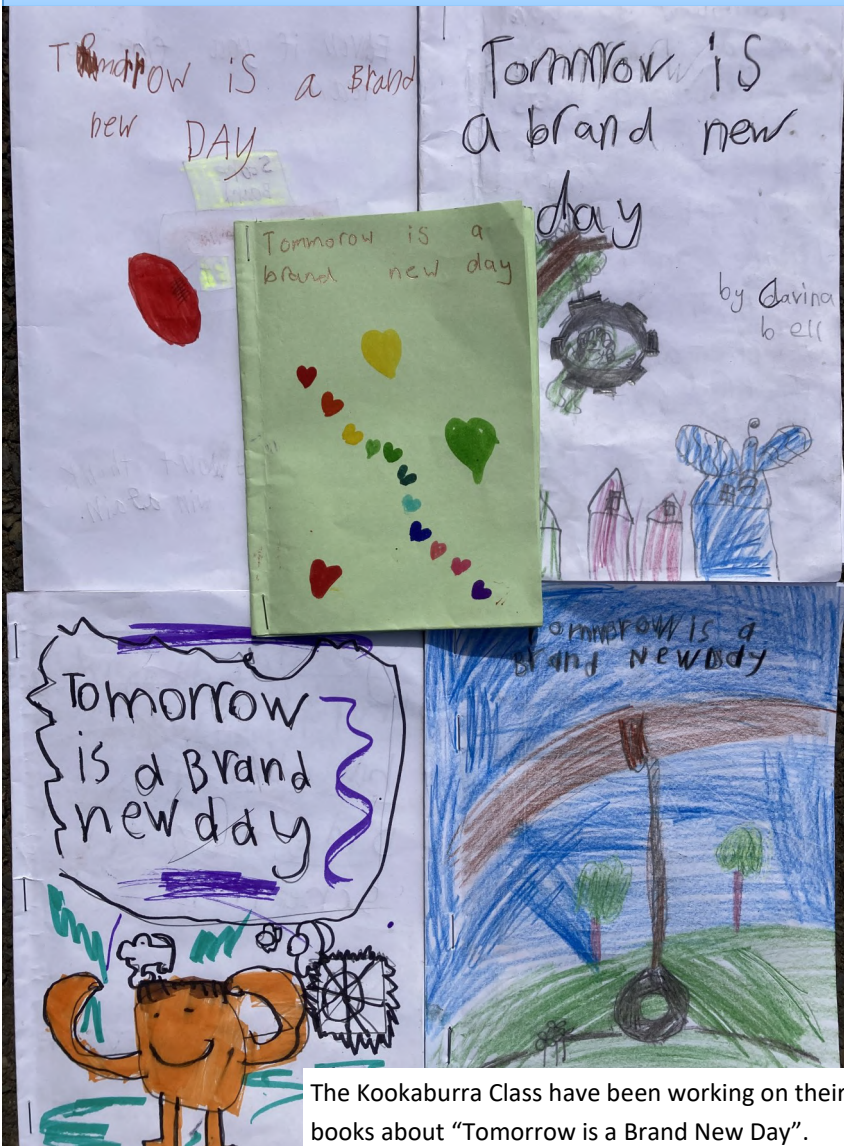

9am **SUNDAY 15th April** - from Gate 3 Scott Creek Road



- Chat about the park's post-fire regeneration and associated weed control;
- Find out more about its history, flora and fauna and its birds (with a short visit to birdbanding);
- Relax with a BYO morning tea at *Tom's Outlook* - views across the park to the south coast!

Walk is about 2.5 kms morning tea site. Come for as long as you wish; return to Gate 3 when it suits you. *It's gently uphill 500m to birdbanding; left 900m along a mainly flat track with a few gentle slopes; then right to go uphill 600m to have your morning tea (nearly to Gate 8).* [•You can continue on to make it into a loop walk].
