On Monday and Tuesday mornings the year 3 students work together as a group for literacy and numeracy lessons.

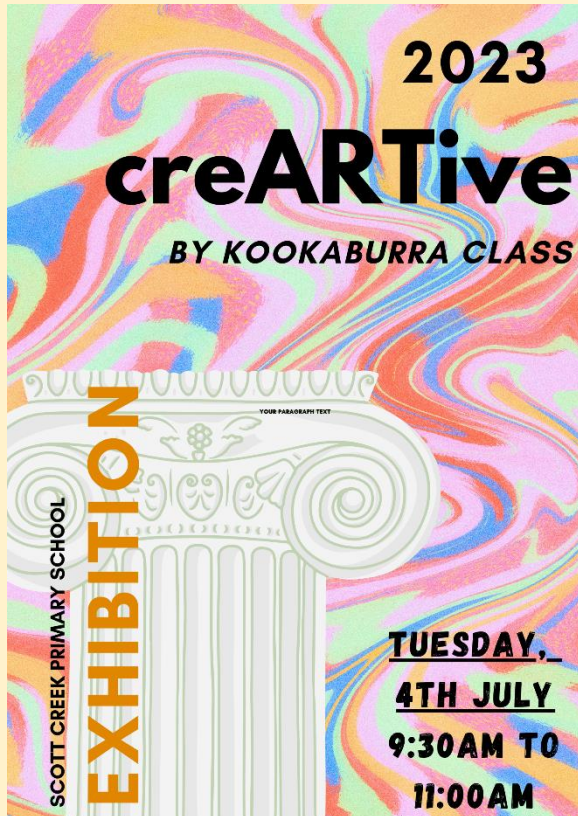
We have been learning about fractions, money, patterns and algebra this term in maths.

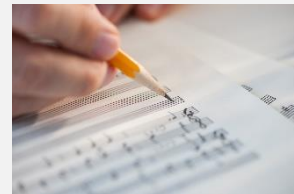


## Music Private Tuition + Drama Program (Semester 2)
