### Principal's Message



Dear Families,

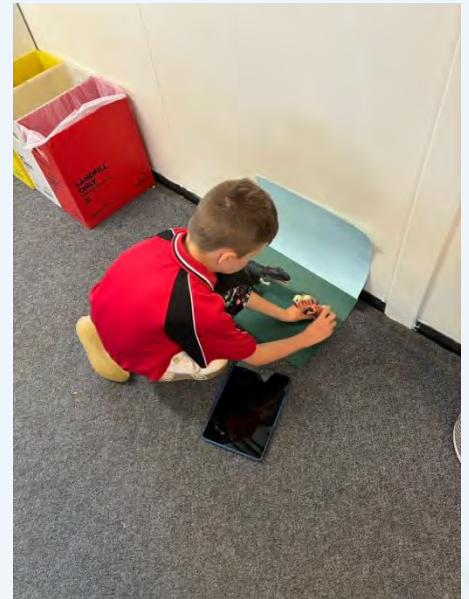
## Classroom News: Kookaburras (Yr. 5/6)

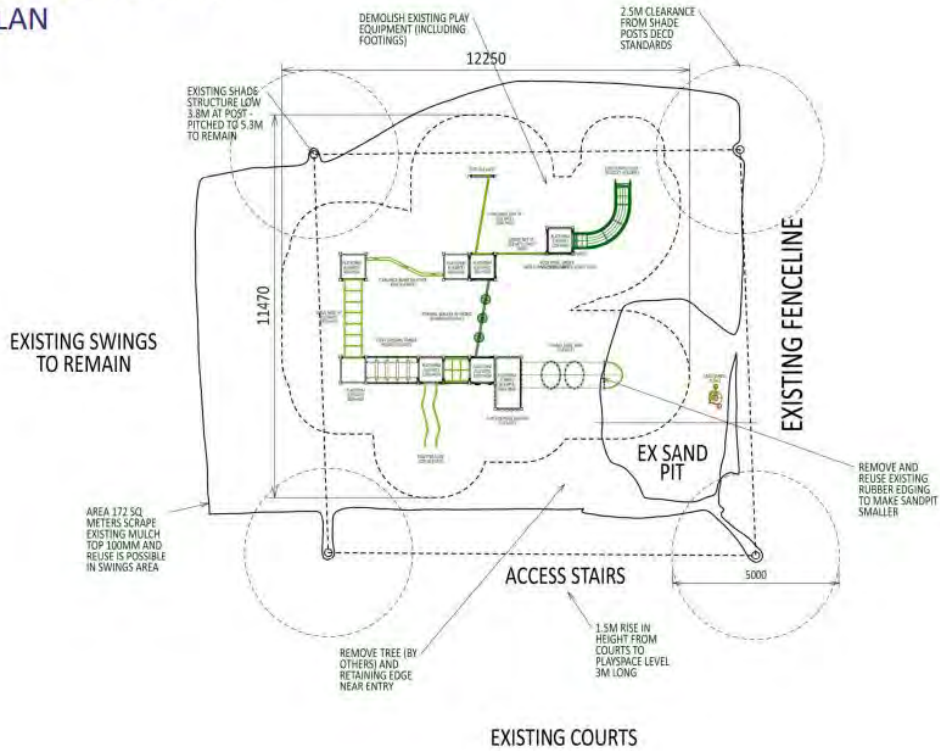

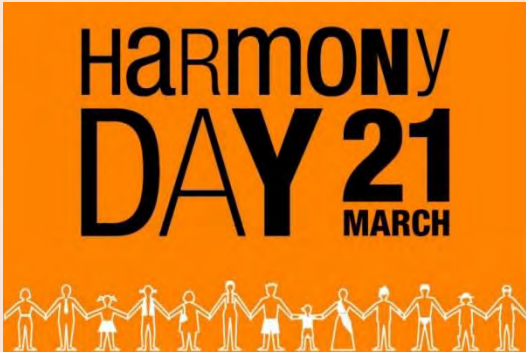
